Studies

- Topics for studies have ranged from pediatric depression to Alzheimer's and diabetes to Crohn's disease.
- The length of a study can range from eight weeks to multiple years.
- Two to three new studies are started per year.



Study participation

- Individuals who participate in medication trials not only receive potentially new beneficial medication, but their experiences also help provide useful information for the field and to advance medicine and science.
- Individuals who participate in research trials are helping the process of creating new knowledge for future patients.
- By conducting research studies with a variety of populations from children to adults, we have been able to develop a timeline study for people with type 1 diabetes and help prove the beneficial effects of a medication for mild dementia due to Alzheimer's disease.

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
