Environmental influences on Child Health Outcomes (ECHO) is a research program supported by the National Institutes of Health (NIH), to enhance the health of children. ECHO paired with the IDeA States Program to create an interventional branch of research: ECHO IDeA States Pediatric Clinical Trials Network (ISPCTN) with the goal to ensure that children in states with historically low NIH funding have access to clinical trials. **SPeCTr is the Kansas arm of ECHO ISPCTN.**
